



Project SEARCH High School Transition Program Entrance Criteria

- Be at least 18 years of age.
- Completed high school credits necessary for graduation.
- Agree that this will be the last year of student services and will accept diploma at the end of the school year.
- Meet eligibility requirements for Vocational Rehabilitation Services.
- Meet eligibility requirements for the Division of Developmental Disabilities and other service providers for follow along services (preferred but not necessary).
- Have independent personal hygiene and grooming skills.
- Have independent daily living skills.
- Maintain appropriate behavior and social skills in the workplace.
- Take direction from supervisors and change behavior.
- Be able to communicate effectively.
- Utilize public transportation when available and participate in travel training to ensure success in traveling independently.
- Have previous experience in a work environment (including school, volunteer, or paid work).
- Be able to pass drug screen and felony check and have immunizations up to date.
- Have the desire and plan to work competitively in the community at the conclusion of the Project SEARCH program.
