

## Y.A.L.E. School COVID-19 Protocols 2022-2023    Community Level - **Yellow** or **Orange**

<b>Exposed individuals regardless of vaccine status</b>	None	Test on Day 6 or immediately if symptoms develop. Test results to School Health Office	Remain in School <b>unless</b> symptoms develop or test results are positive	Monitor Symptoms for 10 days: Wear a well fitted Mask 10 Days • Mask indoors and outdoors through Day 10 while at school • Keep at least 6' distance when unmasked for eating or drinking • Quarantine at home while not in a school setting through day 5 post-exposure.  CANNOT participate in extracurricular activities where consistent masking is not possible through Day 10.

- ★ Stay home in isolation at least 5 full days
- ★ If symptoms have resolved, return on day 6. If symptoms continue, return when resolved. Note that you must be fever-free for at least 24 hours without the aid of fever-reducing medicine.
- ★ \*Wear a mask at all times (except when eating) through day 10

### VACCINATED:

Any student over age 5, who has had both vaccines and is 14 days post second dose and has had 1 booster, anyone over 5 years of age must have booster to be considered "Up-To-Date."  
OR has tested positive for COVID in the last 90 days.

**UNVACCINATED:**

Any student who has not had any vaccines, OR there is no evidence of the vaccines,  
OR has not completed the vaccine protocol including the 14-day waiting period OR has not received a booster if eligible.

**CLOSE CONTACT:**

Within 6 feet of someone with suspected or known COVID-19 for 15 or more minutes during a 24-hour period.

**EXPOSED INDIVIDUALS:**

Close contact 2 days prior to individual's symptom onset (or positive test date if asymptomatic) to 5 days after onset.
